

Dear Families,

Beginning School Year 2022-2023, <u>Free/Reduced Meal Applications will need</u> to be completed for students to receive free/reduced meals. Meals will <u>NOT be free to all students</u>. Lawmakers have not yet agreed to extend the waivers for free meals for all students past June 30, 2022. If the waivers are not extended, to qualify for free meals during the upcoming school year, a family of three must earn less than roughly \$30,000. This means that starting in August, 2022, schools will return to the three-tiered system of free, reduced and paid meals. Applications for free/reduced meals will be available at each school beginning July 1, 2022. All families need to complete a Free/Reduced Meal Application prior to school starting August 10, 2022. If a Free/Reduced application is not on file, the student will be a "paid" status and will need money for all meals. Parents/Guardians are responsible for these paid meals.
